Call for PhD applications

The Department of Biology, University of Crete (U.o.C.), is warmly inviting prospective candidates to apply for PhD studies throughout the year.

Applicants must be holders of a Master's degree awarded by a Greek University or a Foreign University recognized by DOATAP. The candidates' background knowledge must be relevant and of equivalent quality standards as those of our Department. Applicants must have obtained a minimum of 300 ECTS credits from two distinct academic degrees: a Bachelor's degree and a Master's degree, in accordance with the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS).

Holders of Integrated Master's degrees (single-cycle programmes combining undergraduate and postgraduate levels) are not eligible to apply..

Candidates who do not hold a Master's Degree may be accepted, as long as they comply with the Department's prerequisites.

Candidates should submit the application using the https://postgrad.cict.uoc.gr website only. If you are using it for the first time, you will be required to register submitting your personal data.

The application and supporting documents are submitted electronically via the website https://postgrad.cict.uoc.gr where applicants must create a user account in order to process their application.

- 3.Two letters of recommendation (indicate the names and e-mails of the persons from whom the letters of recommendation have been requested). The letters of recommendation will be sent directly by the authors).
- 4.One photo ID.

- 5. Thesis acceptance letter from the supervisor of the doctoral thesis
- 6. Application for the establishment of a three-member advisory committee (the corresponding form is available on the platform Supplementary files)
- 7. Summary of the proposed topic for the PhD thesis
- 8. Full curriculum vitae, including information on the candidate's studies, research or professional activity, possible

scientific work and interests.

- 9. Copy of a BSc degree
- 10. Copy of MSc diploma.
- 11. Certificate of analytical marks of the BSc degree and the MSc Diploma
- 12. Documentation of sufficient knowledge of English (level B2)
- For holders of equivalent degrees from foreign universities, the copies of the BSc degree and MSc Diploma and the transcripts of records must be either in English (from English-speaking Departments) or in Greek language (with official translation from the Greek Embassy or from a certified lawyer).
